The Caribbean Dance Platform project aims to support young Caribbean artists, including choreographers, dancers, performers, and related technical professionals, by enhancing their technical skills and enriching their professional competencies. The ultimate objective is to contribute to the inclusive and sustainable socio-economic development of the region through culture.

Ten young emerging Caribbean artists will receive assistance with production and distribution. Innovative tools will be developed to stimulate these new cultural sector and market, including the creation of a dedicated platform featuring videos of dancers, tutorials, and documentary resources.

In addition, a network of international distribution partners, both American and European, will also be set up.

Lastly, the project will be aimed at all audiences, with a particular focus on young people from disadvantaged neighbourhoods and ghettoised housing estates, girls and women who are victims of various forms of violence, and the informal LGBT community, which faces considerable stigmatisation in Haiti.
