The **ELAN – Arts de l’oralité et du récit** project seeks to stimulate a new cultural dynamic in the field of oral and storytelling arts in West Africa, focusing on Benin, Burkina Faso, Côte d’Ivoire, Guinea, Mali, Niger, Senegal, and Togo.

As part of this initiative, storytelling artists will receive professional digital support, from creation to production, and distribution of their work.

This will result in the production of five collections of stories in the «Ziri Collection» and 80 audio stories that will be distributed on digital download and pay-per-view platforms.

In addition, there will be three skills-building workshops for players in the storytelling arts sector, as well as a ‘Family Storytelling Night’ (La Nuit du conte en Famille), an annual event that will take place both face-to-face and online. Finally, this project, which aims to raise the profile of artists in the sector and improve their economic profitability, will serve as an example to other regional cultural players.
