Les **Arts-liances** project's main objective is to create a sustainable and professional network to promote the dissemination and circulation of performing arts (theatre and choreography) in West Africa, in five partner countries: Benin, Burkina Faso, Côte d'Ivoire, Ghana, and Togo.

In this context, 15 theatrical and choreographic performances will be created and showcased, with the aim of arousing interest in the theatrical arts and, ultimately, establishing a genuine 'rendez-vous' with African audiences.

The skills of artists and performance professionals will be consolidated, while the capacities of venues will be strengthened and optimised in terms of reception, distribution, and visibility through promotional activities.

Finally, cultural and political authorities will be sensitised to facilitate the movement of artists in the five countries of the West African sub-region, taking into account cooperation agreements.
