The '**Agbodrafo Village of the Arts**' project aims to enable the population of this fishing village in Togo, located around thirty kilometers east of Lomé, to have access to various forms of artistic expression while contributing to the tourist and economic development of the village.

In this regard, creative workshops promoting access to artistic and cultural education for the local population have been organized. As a result, a residency related to the visual arts has highlighted several domains such as photography, sculpture, painting, writing, and filmmaking. This culminated in the organization of an artistic walk through the streets of Agbodrafo.

Furhermore, a tourist map of the city and its region was created in collaboration with the municipality. An exhibition throughout the urban space involved the population and showcased local artistic creations and cultural heritage.

Finally, a platform for cultural and artistic exchanges was established between local and international artists by the cultural centre 'Les Changeurs'. The association plans to develop a series of activities over the next two years.
