The '**Cameroonian Cultural Network**' project aims to create a digital and physical platform to establish a robust network in Cameroon to support performing artists.

With this goal in mind, calls for applications were initiated for the 10 productions, with the jury (consisting of 10 members) appointed by the Board, and for the selection of associated cultural spaces.

Training workshops have enhanced the skills of artists and managers of cultural venues in event management, project management, communication, and creative techniques, preparing them to organize shows that will benefit the local community and ultimately contribute to the creation of a value chain for cultural and creative industries in Cameroon.

Furthermore, networking and connections among players in the Cameroonian cultural scene were encouraged. All stakeholders collaborated to plan and organise tours of the 10 selected venues to cover all 10 regions of Cameroon.

Lastly, the cultural venues hosted the performances and managed community communication and related projects developed in collaboration with local organisations.
