The **'Cinema for All'** project aims to provide cultural education, foster artistic practice, and encourage the critical reception of images among audiences, especially young people, in culturally disadvantaged regions, all while promoting the creation and dissemination of cultural goods and services.

As a result, 100 screening and debate sessions were organized in five culturally disadvantaged regions of Cameroon. Educational discussions, involving cinema professionals, were also arranged. Five African films were acquired to support this initiative.

Furthermore, five film workshops were conducted in schools, five film clubs were established and operated within schools, and five short films were produced with active participation from young individuals.

Lastly, a campaign to raise awareness about the critical reception of images through social networks was carried out, involving 100 young leaders. Ultimately, the project will contribute to building a community of cinephiles, leading to increased income, job creation, and the development of the cultural sector in Cameroon.
