The project '**Setting up digital mini labs in schools**' aims to digitise African artistic and cultural works and promote the educational use of virtual reality technologies in urban and rural schools.

In this context, elements of the national heritage to be promoted to this new audience have been collected.

Moreover, 4 fixed digital mini-labs have been installed in Libreville, Port-Gentil and Makokou. To this end, 10 supervisors have been trained to maintain the system and run virtual workshops.

A platform and a 3D virtual museum have been developed and configured to give this new audience access to the opportunities offered by the 4.0 cultural economy.

Ultimately, 20,000 secondary school students will be trained and given access to cultural content via the platform, and at least 10 artists will be supported in the digital transition of their 3D promotional activities.



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
