The **Kaduna Fashion and Arts Exhibition (KAFART)**, an exhibition of fashion and arts from the state of Kaduna, aims to establish effective channels to connect African creatives with a global audience, while encouraging creators to adopt an environmentally friendly approach and promote craftsmanship and ecological ideas to improve the current state of the environment.

In this perspective, the third edition of the 'Kaduna Fashion and Arts Exhibition' took place in Kaduna from 10-13 November 2022, under the name 'Cultural Xchange: The Intersection'.

On this occasion, numerous additional activities were offered to creators, artists, and artisans during the art exhibition, including workshops, master classes, roundtable discussions, pop-up shops, and a fashion show.

In parallel, a buying and selling session was organized to allow small business owners to showcase their products, sell them, and expand their customer base.

Ultimately, the project has a threefold long-term vision, generating economic impact through its unique content that reflects the culture and heritage of the region, social impact by fostering harmony among the different religious and ethnic groups living in the region, and the cultural impact by contributing to the documentation of certain cultural aspects.
