The ‘**Caribbean Premier Jewellery Internship Programme**’ seeks to renovate and upgrade Reve’s production plant, a Jamaican jeweler founded in 2006, and transform it into a world-renowned Caribbean brand. This transformation will enable it to generate profits and increase the number of skilled workers for employment in local and regional industries.

To this end, an emergency plan will be implemented. Manufacturing output will be increased by 300% and the company’s online shop will be relaunched by expanding the product range to meet regional and international demands.

In addition, training programs and workshops will be instrumental in enhancing the professional development of participants. Creatives and members of minority groups will be encouraged to launch their own projects and businesses.

Finally, a plan for the adoption of solar panel and/or wind turbine technology will be developed, with ongoing monitoring of the long-term impact of renewable energy systems on the company’s environmental sustainability.
