The “**Facilitators and Educators Training in Education**” (FETE) project aims to strengthen the Creative Caribbean programme in terms of curriculum development and expert training. It aims to improve the skills of facilitators and educators working with children aged 8 to 13 by developing and implementing programmes focusing on VAPA subjects, i.e. the visual and performing arts. This project provides an opportunity for children to succeed, particularly those from disadvantaged or repressive backgrounds.

As part of this, digital surveys will be submitted to educators and facilitators to gather information and suggestions on the areas and issues to be addressed. A specification and marketing plan will be drawn up to promote the project.

In addition, creative modules will be designed, incorporating elements aimed at teaching the transmission of knowledge in the VAPA fields. The skills of facilitators and educators will be enhanced through certified training courses.

Finally, an online platform or website will be set up to provide ongoing support, as well as permanent access to resources and communication for programme participants.
