The **Scriptwriting, Directors and Editing Workshops - Khartoum** project aims to improve the quality and/or quantity of creative and cultural goods and services.

In this context, training programs and workshops in film production and visual art for emerging filmmakers were conducted and mentorship was provided to selected filmmakers, facilitating knowledge and skill transfer from experienced professionals.

Moreover, high-standard media coverage and production tools were offered to aid filmmakers in producing quality content. Community and cultural monthly events were planned to engage the community through film and media.

Connections were facilitated between Sudanese artists and filmmakers with their peers in East Africa and the Nile valley, enhancing regional collaboration.

Furthermore, film screenings and showcases promoted emerging filmmakers work and fostered a film appreciation culture.

Finally, digital platforms were used for showcasing films and training and ensured adaptability and broader reach, key for sustainability in the modern digital era.
