## Creation of short films and film screening in rural areas of Togo

The project '**Creation of Short Films and Film Screening in Rural Areas in Togo**' aims to bridge the gap between emerging cinematic talents and training opportunities, particularly in remote rural regions.

In this context, a workshop focused on training 20 Togolese participants in cinema-related professions was held in Défalé, northern Togo.

Under the guidance of 10 professional cinema mentors, the participants created two short films (a documentary and a fiction) reflecting themes and stories important to local communities.

Their creations were screened during a national tour of 30 screenings, primarily in rural areas and schools, thus targeting populations distant from traditional cinematic distribution circuits.

To broaden the audience and reach a wider public within the country, the films were also broadcasted on local Togolese television channels.

Lastly, the project contributed to building a stronger and more diversified film industry in Togo, thereby enhancing its capacity to support future projects and talents.
