The '**Faim de Contes**' project aims to enhance Africa's rich oral heritage through the promotion of traditional national storytellers.

The gathering of ten African storytellers, including six from various regions of Côte d'Ivoire and four each from Mali, Niger, Senegal, and Togo, created a platform for cultural exchange and experience sharing between storytellers from different African regions.

In this way, these storytellers, whose talent is not sufficiently recognized, were able to benefit from training workshops aimed at strengthening their storytelling skills and improving the quality of their artistic performance, thereby enhancing their professional careers while ensuring the vitality and continuity of this art.

Finally, the oral tales have been transcribed into books via audio and video recordings, enabling a wider audience, well beyond local communities, to access these stories and extend the reach of storytelling while preserving these traditional tales as intangible heritage for future generations.
