The '**Impala project**' aims to support the creation and production of documentary films and facilitate access by young authors and producers to national and international markets.

In this perspective, ten young authors and ten young producers under the age of 35, including at least 50% women, from Côte d'Ivoire, Burkina Faso, Mali, Niger, Senegal, and Togo, with prior experience of at least one film directed or produced, were able to develop new documentary films projects.

Guided by experienced mentors, they alternated between writing workshops and on-site production, as well as remote exchanges. This strengthening of skills enabled them to reach a level of quality and excellence in line with the expectations of national and international funding bodies in a highly competitive environment.

Furthermore, participants were able to present their film projects to around thirty professionals in the documentary film industry, including co-producers, broadcasters, representatives of documentary film markets and festivals, and funds consolidating professional networks.

Finally, the project contributed to the continuous development of the documentary film industry in West Africa and encouraged diversity and inclusion.
