'**La Fabrique de Fictions**' aims to reposition the common spaces of peri-urban areas at the forefront of artistic creation, in order to bring forth imaginations that reflect and unite the local community.

In this context, two male authors and two female authors were offered a writing residency. They were immersed in peri-urban neighborhoods of Lomé for a month, where they chose a specific location and wrote a play inspired by this setting.

As a result, writing workshops aimed at residents of peri-urban neighborhoods were organized and designed to encourage literary and theatrical creation within the local community.

Encounters were also organized between the artists and the local community to foster cultural exchange and strengthen the bonds between creators and residents.

Furthermore, the plays written during the residency were staged and broadcasted to offer residents direct access to quality theatrical works while contributing to revitalizing the cultural life of peri-urban neighborhoods in Lomé.

Finally, the community cultural work model developed by the project can be replicated in other neighborhoods or cities, allowing for an expansion and sustainability of cultural impact.
