The **32 East Studio Futures** project aims to support 27 artist residencies managed by 32° East over an 18-month period. Its goal is to provide artists with the space and support needed to experiment with new ideas and materials, in order to build their own artistic identity.

Within this framework, the residencies are targeted towards early to mid-career artists and are evaluated based on their interest in experimentation and unique perspectives. Artists selected for the 2023 residencies are also expected to focus their practice on community engagement.

The selection committee consists of a former resident artist, a member of the Arts Collaboratory network, a member of the Triangle network, and local partners.

Each resident artist will receive logistical support, including a per diem, material budget, documentation access to the library, poster design, meetings with artistic directors and journalists, as well as opportunities for collaboration with other members.

Finally, the increase and improvement of the production of creative and cultural goods and services, along with skill enhancement, will enable artists to create more and grow further.
