The project provided training and mentorship to youth and community members on cultural preservation, equipping them with the skills and knowledge necessary to safeguard their cultural heritage.

Platforms and opportunities for cultural learning were created, engaging community members in an inclusive manner in activities such as cultural workshops, storytelling sessions, and traditional performances to facilitate learning about their culture.

Moreover, the project focused on collecting and refining both tangible and intangible cultural goods and services. Tangible cultural artefacts were collected from rural areas and placed in museums for protection.

The project conserved cultural knowledge by recording cultural performances, documenting traditional practices, and establishing digital archives of cultural materials.
