The **'Santuri Salon'** project aims to support the music industry in East Africa, with a focus on inclusion, education, and artistic innovation.

In this regard, this former beauty salon has been transformed into a multifunctional creative space.

The project has established a permanent base for innovative music production courses aimed at training over 100 artists, both young and from East Africa, as well as artists from underrepresented styles, non-male artists, and members of the LGBTQ+ community.

A semi-commercial studio has been set up, prioritizing free access to state-of-the-art equipment serving as a focal point for the development of music projects, hosting residencies, and master classes.

Individual music production has been made available to the community for music creation using tools provided by partners. Technical music events have been regularly organized.

Monthly showcases of experimental artists have been featured, and artists have had the opportunity to present their work as part of global-scale projects.

Finally, the project has fostered educational and intercultural artistic collaborations, while also enabling the creation of strong networks for beneficiaries.
