The **Uzinduzi** project focuses on capacity building in cultural entrepreneurship, the establishment of heritage centers for youth, and the promotion of traditional clothing and design.

In this regard, a heritage center has been established at Lamu Fort, focusing on five thematic areas: cultural heritage, incubation, resource center, entrepreneurship, and technology. The space has been equipped with relevant ICT tools to enhance traditional artwork in various formats intended for use in textiles, interior decorations, packaging, and other printing materials.

Additionally, support has been provided to marginalized groups, with the heritage center aiming to reach marginalized groups in Lamu County, serving as an exchange center for youth from different regions of the country.

Furthermore, a traveling exhibition on the development of Kanga has been organized to attract disadvantaged youth, women, and persons living with disabilities to the creative industries.
