The '**Artirium 1.2+**' project aims to strengthen the structure of the Artirium digital platform by investing in pedagogical techniques to transmit creative skills to young people from disadvantaged or challenging backgrounds.

Within this framework, 15 training tutorials on performing arts and cultural management have been produced and made available online, reaching a larger number of participants.

Moreover, 18 young people from disadvantaged and challenging backgrounds have been introduced to artistic practice, including urban dance and comedy. In this regard, educational tutorials based on this process (to be disseminated to stakeholders and operators in the sub-region) have been created.

Additionally, an online competition cycle focusing on African-inspired contemporary dance and comedy (for those under 30) has been organized.

This increased visibility has allowed these young people to enhance their chances of exporting their works and making their talent known to a wider audience.

Finally, the technical strengthening of Artirium has improved its capabilities and infrastructure to better support artistic and cultural activities.
