The '**CLAPE.EBURNIE.21-23**' project aims to foster collective engagement from all sectors of Ivorian society in raising awareness of and combating pregnancies among young students.

In this regard, the «Kamissa Tour» was planned and organized as a tour to screen the feature film titled «Kamissa» across 20 cities and municipalities in Côte d'Ivoire. This provided populations with a cinematic offering after 30 years without cinema.

Furthermore, the circulation and dissemination of the feature film in twenty cities and municipalities of Côte d'Ivoire were organized, making this cinematic work accessible to the populations. This helped curb youth idleness.

In parallel with the release of the novel «Kamissa 2» and the filming of the film of the same name, students, parents, and civil society engaged in combating pregnancies among young girls in school.

Finally, in this vein, decision-makers and partners in the education system have proposed measures for better education of students to prevent risky sexual behaviors.
