Dancing Beyond Our Walls (#2)

The '**Dancing beyond our walls project (#2)**' aims to enhance the artistic capacity and social engagement of young dancers, while also bridging gaps between different generations and social groups through the art of dance. Training sessions were conducted for apprentice dance teachers from Magg'ando to develop their skills in movement transmission and self-expression.

With this aim in mind, an exchange space was created between the dancer artists and marginalized audiences, thus fostering mutual understanding and respect across generations. Specifically, dance and self-expression workshops, focused on artistic exploration and bodily expression, were set up for target groups including minors incarcerated at the Hann Ford B Detention and Correctional Center and elderly individuals at the «Gaspard Camara» Public Hospital.

Lastly, the project has spurred the social engagement of Magg'ando dancers by actively involving them in addressing the needs of their community, while also raising public awareness about the significance of dance in culture and social well-being.
