The **'Denguele Misri Ni Kourou'** project aims to valorize the cultural heritage of Denguele, a district in Côte d'Ivoire, through four historical sites.

In this context, information and communication campaigns have been carried out with administrative, religious, and traditional authorities, as well as leaders of local associations, and also on social media.

Furthermore, the three Sudanese-style mosques in the localities of Samatiguila, Kèlindjan, Dabadougou, as well as Mount Denguele in Odienné, symbol of the Autonomous District of Denguele, have been digitized in 3D.

Moreover, a partnership has been established with private partners (restaurants, hotels, transport companies...) in several cities to attract visitors. Capacity-building actions for the project's steering team and targets (youth, women, and cultural actors) have been implemented to make them more dynamic.

Finally, women in the localities have been provided with literacy training to enable them to offer their services to visitors, and «web days» dedicated to promoting cultural and creative entrepreneurship among youth have been organized.
