The **'INNO-CULTURE'** project aims to preserve and valorize a set of indigenous practices of the people of Northern Togo, with a focus on empowering young girls.

In this regard, 100 young girls under the age of 25 have been supported to develop cultural skills in areas such as traditional dance, initiation ceremonies, games, and environmental awareness. They have also been encouraged to engage with their native languages, histories, and values, while enhancing their critical thinking and female leadership through a writing competition.

Additionally, nearly 100 young girls have been supported and actively participated in project activities. Furthermore, 500 homemakers have been sensitized about supporting young girls.

Lastly, traditions, games, initiation rites, and other practices at risk of disappearing have been preserved, and young girls have developed their critical thinking and analytical skills. A document on indigenous values has been produced and uploaded to YouTube, comprising 50 videos of stories told in native languages and translated into French and English.
