'Power to the People: Strengthening Nevis Heritage Frameworks & Accessibility' is a project aimed at identifying heritage sites and developing a national heritage registry in consultation with communities and property owners.

With this goal in mind, a specific bill for the island has been drafted to support the existing National Conservation and Environmental Protection Act (NCEPA), enhancing the management of Nevis' heritage sites, and ensuring oversight at both local and federal levels.

Furthermore, a national heritage registry and a collections and contacts management system, including public access to collections, have been established. Training for personnel has been provided to manage databases, and prioritization of cultural heritage sites has enabled their protection by the government.

Additionally, a new website has been launched with improved information accessible to the public, including virtual tours, new signage with QR codes, and a new information management system.
