The project aims to produce and distribute a short film titled ‘Sagata’, which addresses social issues and explores themes such as child protection, family and sexual violence, sorcery, and gender in Papua New Guinea (PNG).

In this context, it is planned that ‘Sagata’ will be completed within a four-month timeframe and launched at Paradise Cinema in May 2024. The goal is to ensure that all pre-production activities (scripting, casting, crew and contractor identification, production design), production (film shooting, distribution planning), and post-production (film editing, preparation for public screening) are efficiently conducted to meet the deadline.

Furthermore, the film is expected to be widely distributed in Papua New Guinea and the Pacific region through cinemas, film festivals, television channels, and various media platforms. The objective of this distribution strategy is to maximize the film’s reach and influence while promoting awareness and dialogue on the highlighted social issues.

Finally, the project will support the growth of the creative industry in Papua New Guinea by showcasing local talents and stories, thereby contributing to the development and visibility of the sector.
